TASTING NOTES:

NOSE: Instant vanilla impact. Butterscotch, caramel, honeycomb with grassy notes and malted barley.

PALATE: Sweet and spicy flavours become prevalent. Cotton candy, peach, banana, cinnamon and nutmeg.

FINISH: Apples with the spices becoming herbaceous. Basil, mint and pine. Medium finish.

Situated on the outskirts of Elgin, Linkwood has been quietly producing spirit since 1824 (est. 1821) with only a few short breaks in its near two-century long history. This alone is testament to the quality of the whisky produced at the distillery. One of Scotland's true gems and held in very high regard by whisky aficionados for the quality of its fresh and fruity, yet full bodied spirit style.

Linkwood's carefully constructed spirit is displayed excellently in this single cask bottling. Add to this just the right amount of cask influence from the bourbon hogshead and the result is a perfect duet, providing layer upon layer of new flavours and aromas to discover with every sip.
