### TASTING NOTES:

**NOSE:** Sophisticated and utterly diverse. Earthy tobacco, crème brûlée, resinous oak, dried fruit, nuts and much more.

**PALATE:** As with the nose, but tea leaves, almonds, Brazil nuts and polished oak add further intricacy. A smooth palate.

**FINISH:** A sweeter, fruitier flavour with white pepper spiciness. A long and elaborate finish.

The Lowland located Cambus distillery started life as a mill that was converted into a malt whisky distillery in 1806. After thirty years two patent stills were introduced and the distillery began producing grain whisky. The distillery is now closed, ceasing production in 1993, with a cooperage standing in its place. Naturally closure has resulted in stocks of Cambus whisky becoming incredibly finite and highly sought after. Single Grain Scotch Whisky doesn't always get the same attention as its malt whisky counterpart and when casks of this quality are available that fact becomes all the more perplexing. The 25 year long maturation in a sherry butt has yielded quite simply stunning results for this whisky. An unparalleled smoothness and a breadth of characteristics so wide ranging that it will keep even the most experience whisky drinker endlessly intrigued.
